

### **PASTOR'S PEN**

Hello Church,

Yesterday (Wednesday the 15th), we held what has become our annual Interfaith Thanksgiving service. This year, it involved an even more diverse group of religious organizations as we gathered together to offer gratitude to God for all God has done this past year. Along with the three Abrahamic faiths being represented (Islam, Judaism, and Christianity), this year, we were blessed with members from the Sikh, Buddhist, Hindu, and Baha'I faith communities. Each faith community shared a little bit about their faith as well as a message of gratitude.

Today, as we were celebrating Thanksgiving with the women of our international sewing group, I was asked how I could participate in such an event. This question led to a really good conversation. Her experience in her country of origin had led her to believe certain things about some faith communities that are not entirely accurate. In particular, that at the core of the Muslim faith is violence and hatred toward those who do not believe as they do. I shared that that had not been my experience and that as United Methodists, we believe in the validity of other faith traditions, that I currently sit as the chair of the Division of Christian Unity and Interreligious Relations, that our Bishop has participated in the Interfaith Prayer service held by Iman Arif every Friday afternoon, and that we believe that Christianity is not the only path that leads us to God.

In a world that is so divided over imaginary lines and different belief systems, my prayer this Thanksgiving is that we will strive to see the piece of God that resides in others. It's there ready to be discovered. I see it every day in the diversity of our community and in the love I receive from the people I meet, even those from far off places. I am grateful for that diversity because I know that it opens me up to seeing God more clearly.

This next week, as you sit with family and/or friends around a table filled with more food than you can eat, I pray that you will be open to seeing God a little more clearly as you offer up prayers of gratitude for all the blessings God has bestowed upon you. Happy Thanksgiving!


